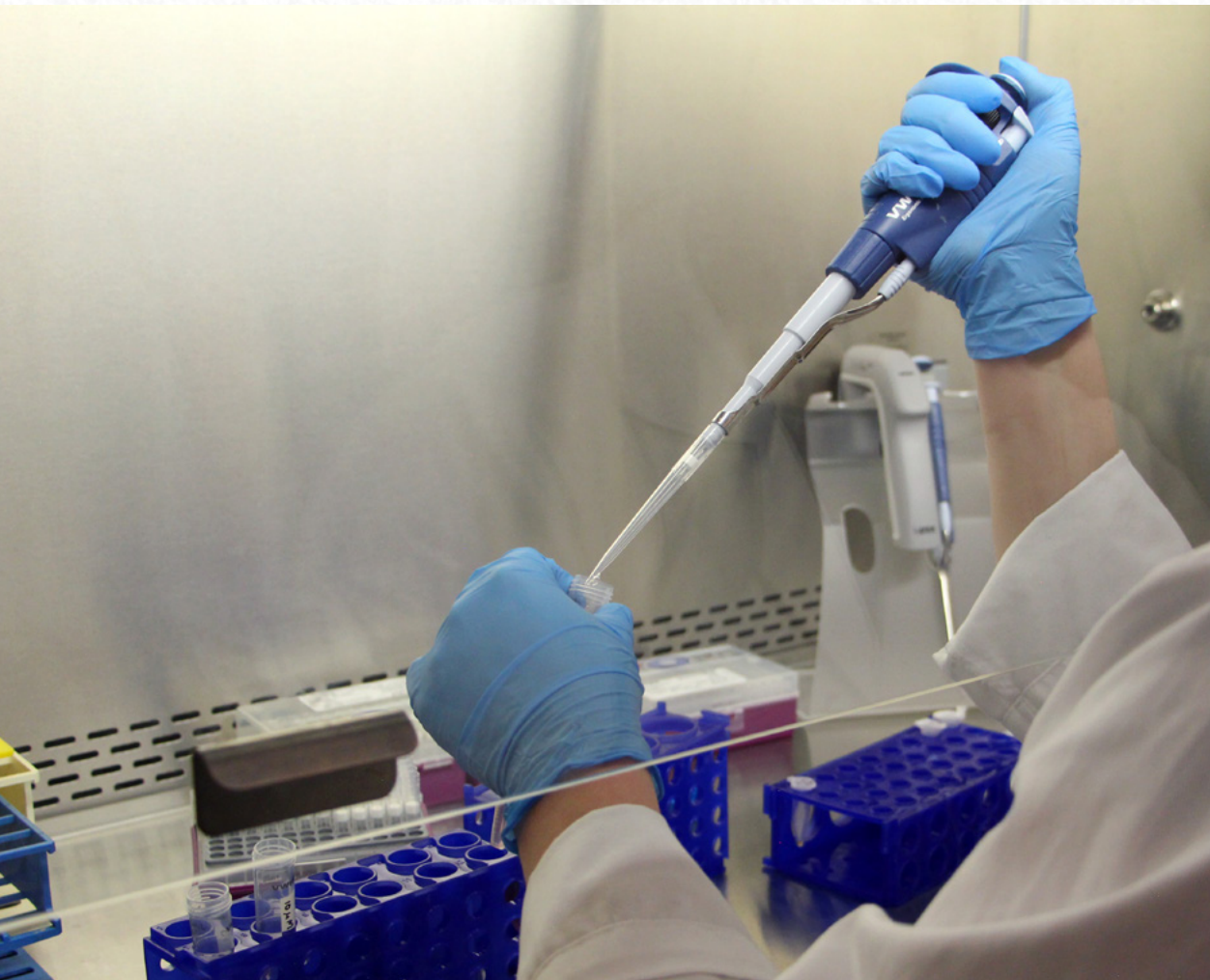
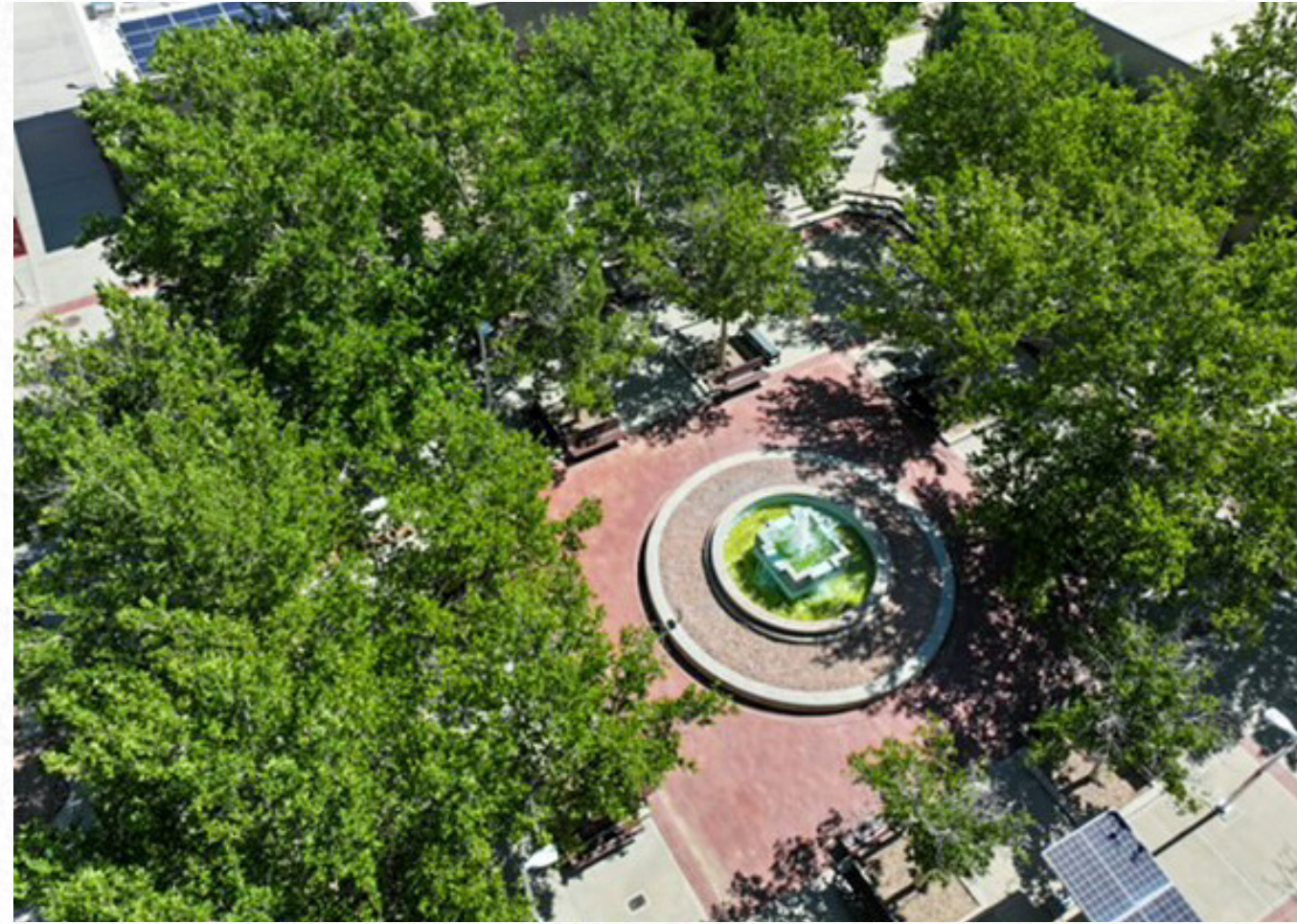


Humanities
