1. Call to order: Elaine Clark called the meeting to order at 1:35pm.

3. Approval of minutes: Cindy Chavez made a motion to approve the minutes from the November meeting with Miriam Gustafson as a second; all were in favor.
4. Executive Director's Report: (Dr. Letteney was not in attendance. Dr. Sax said a few words on her behalf)

- Dr. Letteney will be Washington DC this week and one of the main concerns will be Pell Grants. She will be arguing their importance and asking that the funds not be cut.


## 5. Dean of Instruction Report:

- Summer and fall schedules are currently being worked on and will soon be completed.
- Some of the number of adjunct instructors and the number of course sections need to be cut because of budget.
i. $\$ 161,663$ for summer budget and we are currently $\$ 18,000$ over
ii. This is approximately 7 or 8 courses, we need to cut 3 or 4 sections
- The Strategic Planning Committee will be meeting April $3^{\text {rd }}$ to finalize the plan for the next 3 years.

- Dr. Sax described the Express Lane for registration of returning students that will be available for summer and fall registration.
