

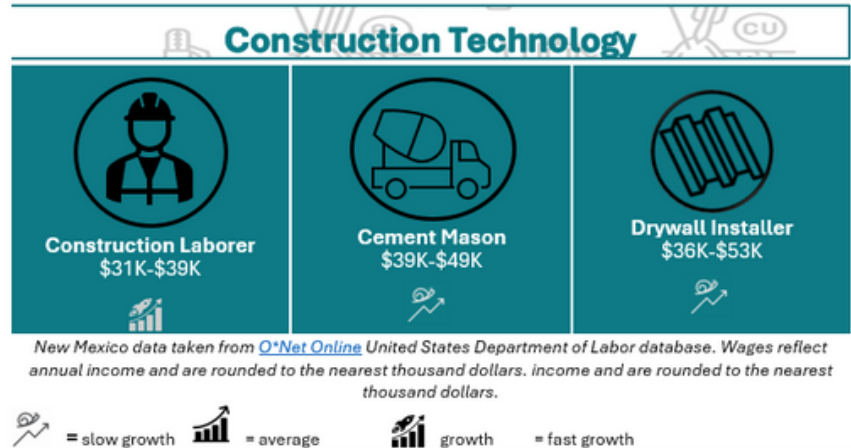
The Construction Technology Certificate program at UNM-Valencia Campus equips students with the skills and knowledge needed for a variety of entry-level positions in the construction industry.
