

With the new Health Order in place, all staff are asked to work remotely for the next two weeks at a minimum. There is no problem with going into campus and getting supplies or other things you need, but unless there is something that requires you to be on campus, please avoid coming in. The requirement of checking in with valsec@unm.edu is still required and very important.

A number of classes will continue on campus through Thursday, Nov. 19. Work necessary to support academics is approved, but most of the administrative staff are working remotely including Finance, HR, and Admin services.

IT will have one person on campus, custodial and maintenance will have a rotating minimal schedule, and police will reduce staffing on campus. Once classes are converted to remote, most buildings will be locked and alarmed and will require someone to escort you into the building. Please anticipate working remotely after Thanksgiving.

In Student Services, Hank Vigil and one other staff member will be on campus until Thanksgiving and working with students by appointment only.
