

We will resume issuing parking permits on Tuesday, July 13, 2021. Hours to pick up your permit are Tuesday through Thursday, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. If you cannot get your permit during these hours, please contact us at valsec@unm.edu, to make other arrangements. Please note the following:

- ID will be verified; bring your UNM ID (preferred) or driver's license and class schedule that clearly shows your UNM ID (Banner) number.
- You will be asked to verify that your vehicle information (license plate, make, model, color) is correct on the request form.
- Contact information will be verified; please note that when conducting UNM business, you should be using your UNM email address. If not provided on the permit request, we will ask for it.
- Access to the Police Department is limited; if you arrive and see that there is someone already in the lobby, please be patient and wait until that individual has completed his/her transaction.

FAQs:

- 1. Permits are free of charge, *first sticker only (per vehicle)*.
- 2. Replacement permits are \$5.00, payable at the Cashier's Office. Present proof of payment to the Police Department to receive a new permit.
- 3. Permit number must be visible; apply to the inside of your windshield, lower left corner (driver's side).
- 4. Handicapped parking is only for those with official handicapped plate/sticker/permit.
- 5. Do not park along curbs, in fire lanes, or the middle of access roads/driveways, or any posted area.
- 6. Visitor parking is for visitors only; faculty, staff, and UNM-Valencia students are not visitors and will be cited for parking in posted visitor parking. If the sign says, "Visitor Only," or "Visitor Parking," do not park there.
- 7. Campus police enforce parking regulations. Violations are \$10.00 per infraction.
- 8. If your vehicle needs to be left on campus overnight or outside of regular hours, please contact the Police at (505) 925-8570 or valsec@unm.edu to obtain permission.
- 9. UNM-Valencia permits are not valid on UNM-Main, and main campus permits are not valid at UNM-Valencia.
- 10. Police officers are happy to escort you to your vehicle, should you desire; call (505) 925-8570 and the on-duty officer will assist you.
